AGENDA SCHEDULE: The timing and order of the topics listed on the agenda are subject to change and will depend on the duration and discussion of the presentations and/or the speaker's availability. Agenda items may be taken out of order. The Commission may take action on any item listed on this agenda. This agenda notice does not include a specific ending time for the Board meeting. The meeting shall end when all of the noticed items and other business have been considered.

STATEMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: Government Code section 11125.7 provides the opportunity for members of the public to address each agenda item before or during discussion or consideration by the Commission. The public will be allowed to address the Commission during Item 3 on any item on the agenda and Item 12 on any item not on the agenda. Individuals may appear before the Commission to discuss items not on the agenda; however, the Commission can neither discuss nor take official action on those items at the time of the same meeting. (Gov. Code, §§ 11125, 11125.7, subd. (a).). Although not required, speakers are requested to identify themselves by stating their name and city of residence for the official record.

All comments shall be addressed to the Commission as a body. Speakers should be brief and limit comments to relevant topics. The Commissioners may elect not to respond to questions or comments during the meeting. Dialog or extended discussion between the public and the Commissioners or staff may be limited per the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act.

SIGN-UP & TIME LIMITS: The Chair will provide an opportunity for the public to comment during the scheduled public comment sections. Public comment will typically be limited to two (2) minutes per speaker; however, the Chair may decide to lengthen the public comment periods at their discretion. If you wish to speak on an item and you are attending the meeting in-person or virtually and you know in advance that you would like to comment, please fill out a "Request to Speak" form and give it to a staff person before the meeting. If you wish to submit a written comment, please send your statement to InfoSSC@caloes.ca.gov prior to the beginning of the meeting.
