Weather Summary

- Lingering moisture over California will continue to produce isolated thunderstorms over the weekend, primarily across far northern California, as well as much of the Sierra Nevada range.
- Storm coverage and potential impacts should be dramatically decreased compared to earlier in the week.
- Isolated showers and thunderstorms will move across Southern California, east and south of Los Angeles County Sunday and Monday.
- Widespread showers and thunderstorms will move across the entire region from south to north Tuesday and Wednesday.

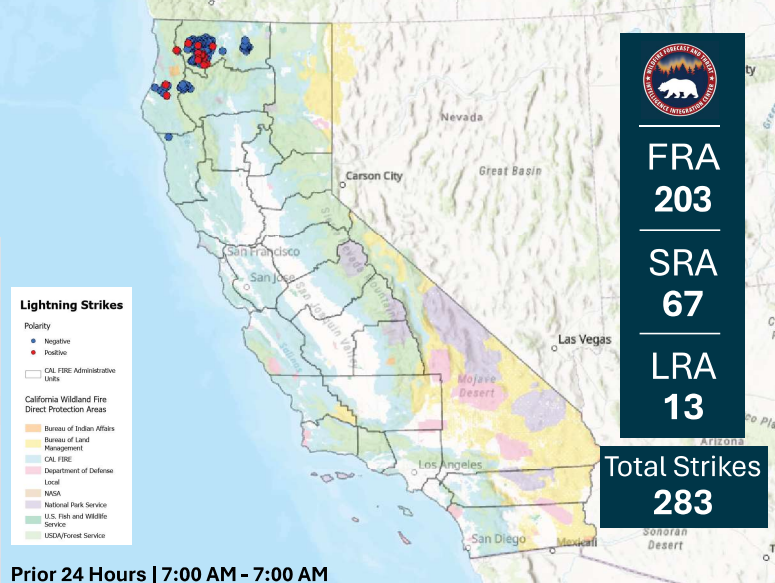

No Active Fire Weather Watches



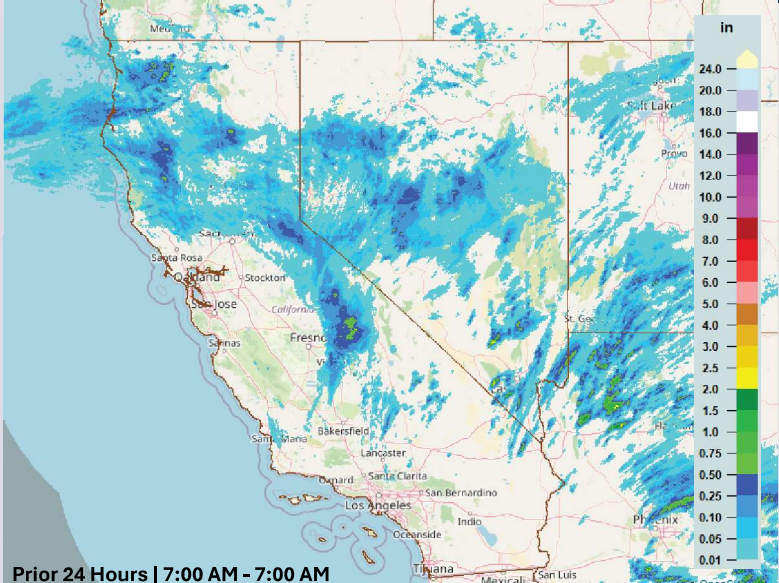

Lightning Activity | September 19 - 20



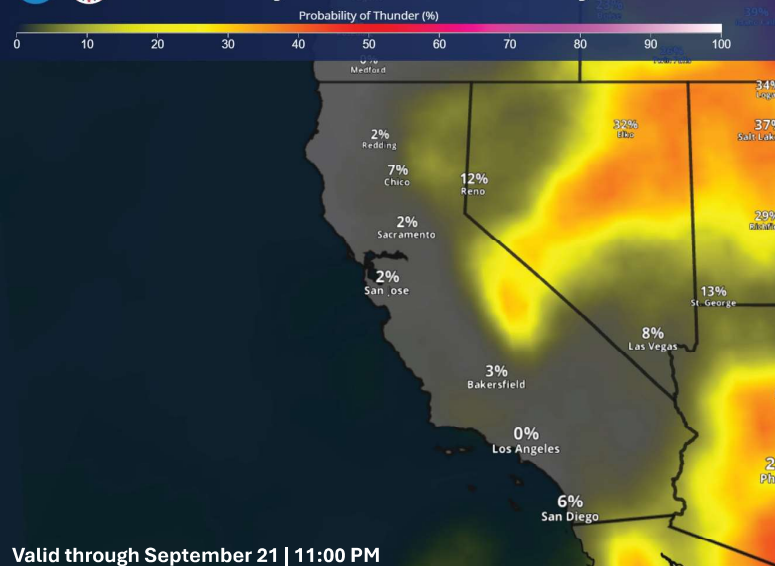
Prior 24 Hours | 7:00 AM - 7:00 AM
