The Summit's theme is A More Resilient California, and the event will provide attendees with the opportunity to:

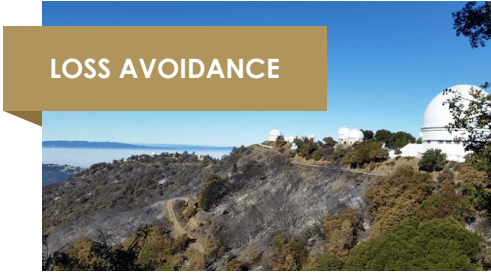
- Gain meaningful insights from state, local, and tribal hazard mitigation experts

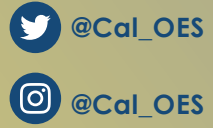
